

Changes for People with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities

If you...

- Live in an ICF-IID*, or
- Get services in one of these waivers:
 - Home and Community-based Services (HCS)
 - Community Living Assistance and Support Services (CLASS)
 - Texas Home Living (TxHmL)
 - Deaf Blind with Multiple Disabilities (DBMD)

Are an adult age 21 or older

Are a child or young adult age 20 or younger

You **must** get basic medical services like doctor visits, hospital visits, and medicines through STAR+PLUS Medicaid managed care.

You can **choose** to get basic medical services like doctor visits, hospital visits, and medicines through STAR+PLUS Medicaid managed care.

If you get Medicaid and Medicare, you will not be affected by this change and will not be enrolled in managed care.
