	<b>Remarks:</b>	Will continue the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) for 12 years and move VR services for visually impaired persons and for disabled persons, the Independent Living program for older adults, Criss Cole Rehabilitation Center, and Business Enterprises of Texas (BET) from DARS to TWC. Will move functions of Human Rights Commission to TWC. Disability determination will remain at DARS/HHSC.

SB 212	Birdwell, Brian(R) Burkett, Cindy(R)	Relating to the abolishment of the Texas Council on Purchasing from People with Disabilities and the transfer of its functions to the comptroller of public accounts.
	<b>Remarks:</b>	Will abolish TCPPD and move functions to the Texas Workforce Commission (originally would have moved it to Comptroller). Will expand the advisory council to include people with disabilities who are employed by contractors under the State Use Program.

SB 219	Schwertner, Charles(R) Price, Four(R)	Relating to the provision of health and human services in this state, including the powers and duties of the Health and Human Services Commission and other state agencies, and the licensing of certain health professionals.
	<b>Remarks:</b>	Cleans up health and human services codes in advance of Sunset legislation. Passage of SB 219 marks the full implementation of the respectful language legislation from 2011. 2,276 pages.

SB 204	Hinojosa, Chuy(D) Raymond, Richard(D)	Relating to the functions of the Department of Aging and Disability Services.
	<b>Remarks:</b>	Among the issues addressed in the DADS Sunset bill are: provisions to address adequate standards in day habilitation; Quality Reporting System improvements; the closure of the Austin State Supported Living Center; and an SSLC Restructuring Commission to determine if additional Centers should be closed.
	<b>Bill History:</b>	05-27-15 H House appointed conference committee Conferees: Raymond-chair, Price, King of Taylor, Workman and Gonzales
